

Nivunki Village Arctic Break 3 Night / 4 Day Itinerary

<u>Day I</u>

0700-1235 (time difference - Finland is 2 hours ahead of UK) Flights depart London Heathrow at approximately 0700 (3.5 hours flight time). On arrival, transfer to Nivunki Village (50 minutes). Check-in to your kota and visit the restaurant for an a la carte meal filled with local delicacies.

2000-2300 Northern Lights Snowmobile Safari

Come with us on a snowmobile tour in search of the Northern Lights, a journey that promises adventurous moments under the Arctic sky. The area in which Nivunki rests is far away from artificial lights and an ideal spot for Northern Lights hunting. This tour is not just about the Northern Lights – it's about experiencing the pure essence of nature in all its forms. On the way we pause in a kota, a traditional Lappish tepee. Nestled amidst the snow-covered landscape the kota offers a cozy break during which we enjoy local treats.

Half Day Husky Adventure

Join us on an unforgettable half-day husky safari adventure, where you'll harness the power of these magnificent Arctic dogs and journey deep into the snowy wilderness. Led by your own team of huskies, you'll experience the thrill of husky ride, guided by the expertise of your experienced musher. After a brief orientation and safety briefing, you'll be paired with your own team of huskies, each one eager and ready to take you on your Arctic journey. Halfway through your safari, we'll stop at a Lappish hut, kota, for a traditional snack and hot drinks. During the break you'll learn more about your four-legged Arctic companions. As your husky safari comes to an end, you'll return to the husky farm with everlasting memories and a newfound appreciation for the incredible bond between humans and dogs.

<u>Day 3</u>

Snowmobile Safari

This snowmobile tour takes you to beautiful sceneries of wilderness lake Nivunkijärvi. In the beginning, our guide explains snowmobile safety and driving instructions in detail, so that everyone feels comfortable start driving the snowmobile. Once everyone is ready, it's time to set off into the snowy

landscape. Follow your guide as you weave through snow-covered forests, across frozen lakes, and along winding trails that showcase the natural beauty of Lapland. Along the way, we'll make a stop at our very own typical Lappish hut, known as a kota. Step inside and warm up by the crackling fire as you sip on a hot drink and indulge in some local treats.

	Meet our reindeer. Home to a hundred reindeer, Nivunki Village offers you the
	chance to experience the ancient art of traversing the wilderness in the heart
	of Lapland. As you glide through the winter landscape, where the silence of the
	wilderness is broken only by the soft thudding of reindeer hooves, you'll find a
	sense of connection to the land and its ancient traditions. Along the way, your
	knowledgeable guide will share you with stories of locals and their deep
	relationship with the reindeer the importance of reindeer herding and the role
	these majestic animals play in sustaining livelihoods in the Arctic.
1600	Transfer to Kittilä airport (approximately 40 mins).
1900	Return flight to UK.
2030	Arrive UK.
