Sample Itinerary

Day 1 Afternoon arrive at Kittilä Airport and transfer to the Arctic Luxury Cabins (about 20 minutes). Lunch at The Lounge, the quintessentially Nordic concierge cabin with floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the forest which includes a restaurant.

Check-in to your cabin.

Mid-Afternoon: 5km Husky Safari

Experience the thrill of a husky safari at a working husky farm, where you'll meet some of the friendly and energetic dogs that call Lapland home. After an introduction to mushing, you'll take the reins and embark on an unforgettable 5km husky safari through the breathtaking Arctic wilderness.

After your ride, warm up with a hot drink by the fire and take the opportunity to ask the mushers about the lives of these incredible sled dogs—how they train, race, and thrive in the snowy landscapes of Lapland.

Day 2 *Breakfast in your cabin.*

Morning: 2km Reindeer Safari

For a contrast to the energetic husky safari, step into the calm and timeless world of the reindeer. On this gentle and peaceful ride, you'll travel through the snowy landscape just as the Sámi people have for centuries. Meet Lapland's most iconic Arctic inhabitants and learn about the deep connection between the reindeer and the region's culture. Your guide will share stories about their importance in Sámi traditions, from herding to daily life in the Arctic. A truly authentic and serene experience that lets you slow down and take in the magic of Lapland.

Lunch in your cabin.

Afternoon: Baking with the Elf & Visit from Santa

After a morning of Arctic adventures, relax and unwind in the warmth of your cabin, where a special visitor awaits! One of Santa's cheerful elves will stop by to spread some festive magic, inviting the children to bake gingerbread cookies together. This cosy experience is the perfect way to embrace the Christmas spirit, creating sweet memories (and delicious treats!) in the comfort of your Lapland retreat. As the evening settles in, experience a truly special moment as Santa arrives at your cabin for a private



family visit. Gather together as he listens to the adventures you've had this year, the memories you've made, and of course, your Christmas wishes.

Day 3 *Breakfast in your cabin.*

Morning: 30km Snowmobile Safari & Children's Snowmobiling

Young adventurers can experience the thrill of riding a mini snowmobile, just like the grown-ups! Children aged 11 and under can take turns zipping around a safe, designated track, giving them a taste of Arctic excitement in a fun and controlled environment. A great way for little ones to enjoy the snow and experience the joy of snowmobiling at their own pace.

After the children, it's time for the adults to step into adventure as you set off on an exciting snowmobile safari through the breathtaking Lappish wilderness. After receiving full driving instructions, you'll follow your guide along extensive snowmobile tracks, weaving through snow-covered forests and open landscapes.

Adults can choose to drive solo or share a snowmobile, swapping drivers along the way if desired. Children and those who prefer to sit back and enjoy the ride will be pulled in a comfortable sleigh driven by the guide, making this an experience for the whole family to enjoy.

Please note: A valid driving license is required to operate a snowmobile.

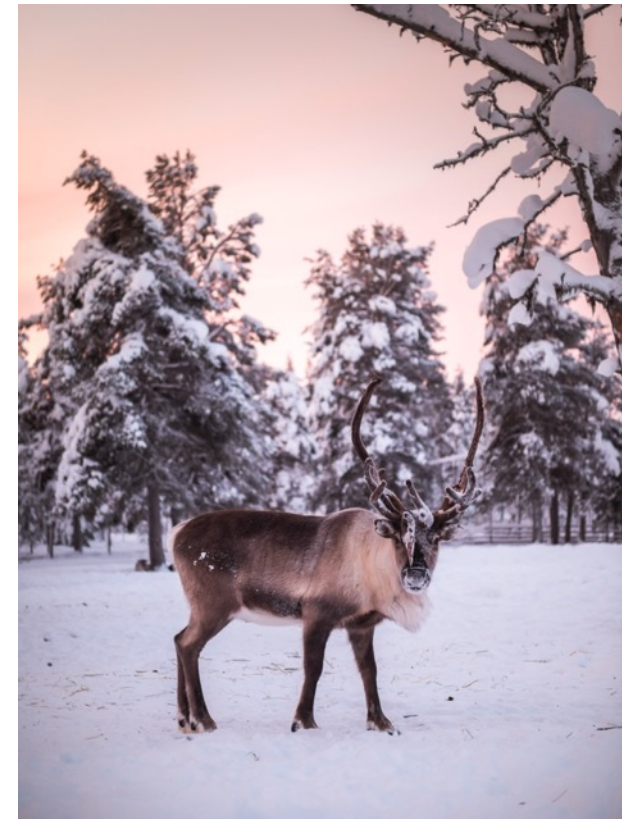
Lunch in your cabin.

Afternoon: Snowshoe Excursion

Strap on your snowshoes and step into the Arctic wilderness! With these traditional winter shoes, you'll find it much easier to walk on deep snow, allowing you to explore the untouched landscapes of Lapland. How far you go is up to you but be prepared to work up a sweat as you trek through the crisp, snowy terrain. A great way to experience the peace and beauty of the winter wilderness at your own pace.

Evening: Crafting with the Elf

One of Santa's elves will visit your cabin for a relaxed Christmas crafting session with the children. They'll have the chance to make their own festive decorations, adding a special touch to the celebrations. With gentle guidance from the elf, the children can enjoy a calm and creative activity, making something to take home as a keepsake of their time in Lapland.

Additional Information

Location: Levi region, Finland, approx. 200km north of the Arctic Circle

Average Temperatures: 0C to -45C

Daylight: 1st – 14th December approx. 1 hour – 30 mins.
14th – 31st December 0 hours of daylight. *This is the special time of Kaamos or Polar Night when the sun does not go above the horizon. There is a twilight light between 10:00 and 14:00.*

Northern Lights: This is a great location to see the Northern Lights. Should the Aurora appear, you will be able to see them from your cabin and do not need to book an additional excursion.

Santa Experience: To make your child's Santa experience truly magical, we'll ask for a little information about them in advance. If your children write letters to Santa, we can also make sure he receives them before your visit. Each child will receive a special letter from Santa, personally inviting them to Lapland, as well as a soft toy to cherish during their visit.
