## Sample 3-Night 4-Day Itinerary

Day I Afternoon: arrive at Kittilä Airport and transfer to your cabin (about 20 minutes). Late lunch in your cabin.

#### Afternoon: Gingerbread Baking in your Cabin with the Host

The host will pay a visit to your cabin, bringing festive cheer and a sprinkle of Christmas magic. They'll guide the children through the delightful tradition of baking gingerbread cookies, filling your cabin with the warm, sweet aroma of the Christmas season.

#### Day 2 Breakfast in your cabin.

#### Morning: Reindeer Farm Visit and Reindeer Sleigh Ride

Immerse yourself in the rich tradition of reindeer husbandry with a guided tour of a working reindeer farm. During your visit, you'll have the chance to feed the reindeer, capture beautiful photos, and spend time up close with them. reindeer herding and its role in Lapland today. To complete the experience, enjoy a scenic reindeer sleigh ride before gathering around for hot drinks, where you can relax and take in the historical surroundings.

Experience the thrill of a husky safari at a working husky farm, where you'll meet some of the friendly and energetic dogs that call Lapland home. After an introduction to mushing, you'll take the lead and embark on an unforgettable husky safari through the breathtaking Arctic wilderness.

After your ride, warm up with a hot drink by the fire and take the opportunity to ask the mushers about the lives of these incredible sled dogs—how they train, race, and thrive in the snowy landscapes of Lapland. N.B. Families with children under the age of 7 have a 2km safari, families with children over the age of 7 have a 5-10km safari depending on weather conditions.

#### Afternoon: Relax & Explore

The afternoon is free for you to enjoy as you wish.


#### Late Afternoon: Host Visit to your Cabin for Christmas Stories and Fun

As evening falls, the host will visit your cabin to tell tales of Santa. Gather around as they share enchanting stories about Santa and his adventures in Lapland, captivating children with tales of Christmas.

#### Late Afternoon: Private Visit to Santa

Enjoy a private meeting with Santa at the cosy Kota, just a short walk from your cabin. Gather around the warm, crackling fire as Santa listens to your Christmas wishes, chats about your year, and shares in the festive spirit. #### Day 4 Breakfast in your cabin and check-out

#### Late Morning/Lunchtime: Snowmobile Safari (2.5 hours)

Embark on a snowmobile safari through the untouched Lappish wilderness. After receiving driving instructions, safety equipment, and advice, you'll set off on the safari. Two adults will share a snowmobile, and children will ride in a sleigh pulled behind the guide's snowmobile.

The safari will stop halfway in the forest for lunch in an Arctic hut.

Afternoon: Visit to Levi

In the afternoon, take a trip to the ski town of Levi, where you can explore a variety of souvenir and boutique shops, perfect for finding unique gifts and keepsakes. As you wander through the town, you'll also find cosy cafés and inviting restaurants, offering the perfect spot to relax.

Transfer to Kittilä Airport

- \* Please note that this is a sample itinerary, and the order of activities may change.
- \* Transfer times to activities are between 15 and 30 minutes.
- \* Group size up to 12 people.
- \* A valid driver's license is required to drive a snowmobile.
- \* The 4-night itinerary includes the same activities with more free time to relax, explore and ski. Additional activities such as Northern Lights excursions and snowshoe walking can be booked once in Lapland.




### Flight Information

**Day of Return:** Depart Kittilä Airport 18:00 Arrive London Heathrow 19:30





Location: Levi region, Finland, approx. 200km north of the Arctic Circle

Average Temperatures: 0C to -45C

Daylight: 1st - 14th December approx.1 hour - 30 mins.

 $14^{\rm th}-31^{\rm st}$  December 0 hours of daylight. This is the special time of Kaamos or Polar Night when the sun does not go above the horizon. There is a twilight light

between 10:00 and 14:00.

Northern Lights: This is a great location to see the Northern Lights. Should the Aurora appear,

you will be able to see them from your cabin and do not need to book an

additional excursion.

Santa Experience: If your children write letters to Santa, we can make sure he receives them

before your visit. Each child will receive a special letter from Santa, personally

inviting them to Lapland, as well as a soft toy to cherish during their visit.

Downhill Skiing: The cabins are in close walking from downhill skiing. Your host can arrange for

skiing equipment to be brought to your cabin (ski equipment rental shop is

about 2km away).
