## New Year's Arctic Break | 27<sup>th</sup> December 2025 – 1<sup>st</sup> January 2026 (5 nights / 6 days)

## Day 2 Breakfast

## Morning: 5km Day Husky Safari

Before setting off on a thrilling five-kilometre husky safari, guests receive a driving tutorial. Adults can take turns driving, swapping at the halfway point to ensure everyone has the chance to experience the excitement of mushing. After the ride, participants gather in a cosy Lappish tepee for a warm drink, where the husky farm guides share fascinating insights about these incredible dogs.





#### Afternoon: Relax & Explore

The afternoon is free for you to enjoy at your own pace. You can hit the slopes for some downhill skiing, explore the scenic trails with cross-country skiing, or take time to discover the local area. If you prefer a more relaxed afternoon, simply unwind and soak in the winter wonderland. For some extra fun, head to the dedicated tobogganing areas at the local ski slopes and enjoy a thrilling ride!

### Day 3 Breakfast

### Morning: 3km Reindeer Ride into the Wilderness

Meet the reindeer—charming, semi-wild Arctic animals. Once they are ready, participants settle into their sleighs, wrapping up in warm blankets for a cosy journey. The three-kilometre ride winds through the untouched wilderness of Lapland, offering a chance to soak in the magical tranquillity of the forest. After approximately half an hour, the experience continues inside a traditional Lappish tepee (kota), where guests can gather around an open fire to enjoy homemade berry juice while listening to fascinating stories about reindeer and their annual cycle of life.

## Morning: Snowmobile Safari

This snowmobile safari offers the perfect introduction to the excitement of snowmobiling and the breathtaking landscapes of Lapland. After receiving essential safety and driving instructions, participants embark on a scenic 25-kilometre journey through the winter wilderness. Around halfway, there is a stop at a cozy Lappish tepee (kota) to warm up with a hot drink and a delicious bun before continuing the





adventure.

The visit includes a guided tour of the hotel, bar and restaurant.

Ylläs region, Finland, approx. 200km north of the Arctic Circle

Average Temperatures:

0C to -45C

Daylight:

 $\boldsymbol{0}$  hours. This is the special time of Kaamos or Polar Night. There is a twilight

light between 10am and 2pm.

Currency:

Euro (cards widely accepted)

In The Area:

There are **downhill ski slopes** less than 10 minutes from Äkäslompolo, which offer equipment rental as well as ski school.

- → Cross-country ski tracks are plentiful in the area and equipment can also be hired locally.
- → Äkäslompolo has several **shops, cafes and restaurants** and most keep regular or only slightly reduced working hours between Christmas and New Year.
- → This is a great location for the **Northern Lights**. Should the Aurora appear, you will be able to see them from your accommodation and do not need to book an additional excursion. The village streetlights are turned off after 10pm to reduce light pollution.
- → On **New Year's Eve** there are fireworks in the village and the ski slopes are open until midnight for NYE skiing. There are also lantern displays on the slopes from the early evening,
