

Nivunki Village Arctic Break | December (4 nights and 5 days)



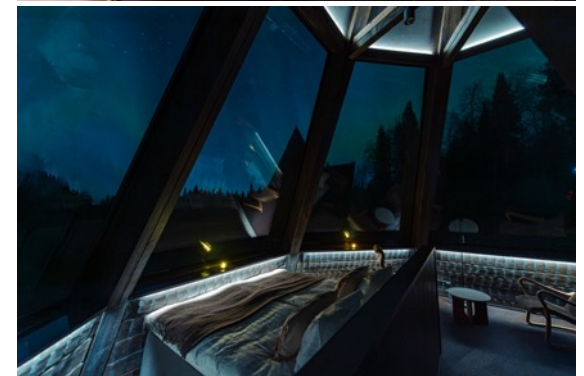

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Sample Itinerary

Day 1 Afternoon arrive at Kittilä Airport, transfer to Nivunki Village (about 50 minutes)
Check-in and dinner

Day 2 Breakfast

Morning: ½ Day Husky Safari (3.5 hours / 18km)

Join an unforgettable half-day husky adventure, where you'll harness the power of these magnificent Arctic dogs and journey deep into the snowy wilderness. Led by your own team of huskies, you'll experience the thrill of the husky ride, guided by the expertise of your experienced musher. After a brief orientation and safety briefing, you'll be paired with your own team of huskies, each one eager and ready to take you on your Arctic journey. Halfway through your safari, we'll stop at a Lappish hut, known as a kota, for a traditional snack and hot drinks. During the break you'll learn more about your four-legged Arctic companions. As your husky safari comes to an end, you'll return to the husky farm with everlasting memories and a newfound appreciation for the incredible bond between humans and dogs. Based on 1 musher and 1 passenger, you can swap drivers at the halfway point.

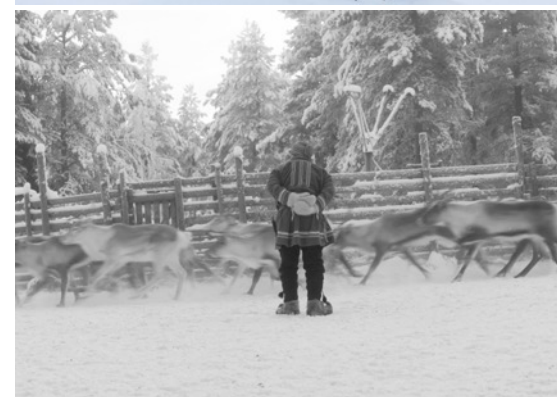
Day 3 Breakfast

Morning: Reindeer Ride into the Wilderness (3 hours / 5km)

Meet the reindeer. Home to one hundred reindeer, Nivunki Village offers you the chance to experience the ancient art of traversing the wilderness in the heart of Lapland. As you glide through the winter landscape, where the silence of the wilderness is broken only by the soft thudding of reindeer hooves, you'll find a sense of connection to the land and its ancient traditions. Along the way, your knowledgeable guide will share you with stories of locals and their deep relationship with the reindeer - the importance of reindeer herding and the role these majestic animals play in sustaining livelihoods in the Arctic.

Evening: Northern Lights Snowmobile Safari (3 hours / 3km)

Driving through the Lappish forest during the nighttime is an experience of its own. Our route winds through untamed wilderness, leading us to the shores of Lake Äkäsjärvi and the historic mill beside the



Äkäsjoki River. This ancient site holds a special place in the region's history, serving as both a vital area for fishing and a peaceful resting spot for travellers throughout the ages. Here, under the Arctic night, there is plenty of time to roam in search for the Northern Lights. While you enjoy a Lappish evening snack, your guide will tell tales of the ancient traditions and spiritual beliefs of the Sámi people, alongside shedding light on the scientific explanation of this light phenomenon. Based on 2 people sharing a snowmobile.

Dinner

Day 4 Breakfast

Morning: Frosty Trails Snowmobile Safari (20km / 2 hours)

This snowmobile tour takes you to beautiful sceneries of wilderness near lake Nivunkijärvi. In the beginning, our guide explains snowmobile safety and driving instructions in detail. Once everyone is ready, it's time to set off into the snowy landscape. Follow your guide as you weave through snow-covered forests, across frozen lakes, and along winding trails that showcase the natural beauty of Lapland. Along the way, we'll make a stop at our very own typical Lappish hut, known as a kota. Step inside and warm up by the crackling fire as you sip on a hot drink and indulge in some local treats. Based on 2 people sharing a snowmobile.

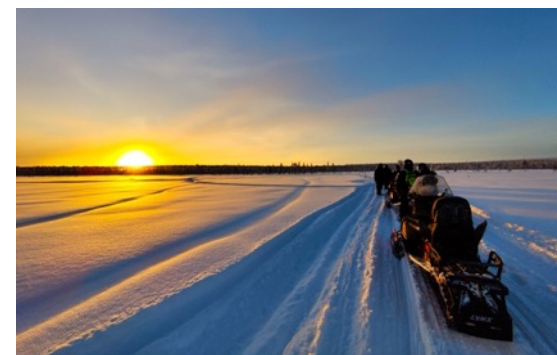
