Sample 3-Night 4-Day Itinerary

Day I Afternoon: arrive at Kittilä Airport and transfer to your cabin (about 30 minutes).

Late light lunch in your cabin.

Afternoon: Meet and Feed The Reindeer

Meet and feed the charming reindeer, affectionately known as The Boys. They spend the winter in The Fell's private yard—your friendly neighbours throughout your stay.

Enjoy a Dinner of Arctic delights in your cabin, followed by hot chocolate and marshmallows by the fire in the cosy Lappish Hut, next to your cabin.

Day 2 Breakfast in your cabin.

Morning: Husky Safari and Visit to the Husky Farm

Experience the thrill of a husky safari at a working husky farm, where you'll meet some of the friendly and energetic dogs that call Lapland home. After an introduction to mushing, you'll take the lead and embark on an unforgettable husky safari through the breathtaking Arctic wilderness.



After your ride, warm up with a hot drink by the fire and take the opportunity to ask the mushers about the lives of these incredible sled dogs—how they train, race, and thrive in the snowy landscapes of Lapland. N.B. The length of the safari will be tailored to your family, taking into account the children's ages and the weather conditions. If safe and suitable, the journey can be up to 10km long.

Lunch in your cabin

Afternoon: Relax & Explore

Enjoy free time to relax and explore—warm up by the fire, unwind in the sauna, or head back out for more snowy fun!

Mid-Afternoon: Gingerbread Baking in your Cabin with the Host followed by a Visit from Santa

The host will pay a visit to your cabin, bringing festive cheer and a sprinkle of Christmas magic. They'll guide the children through the delightful tradition of baking gingerbread cookies, filling your cabin with the warm, sweet aroma of the Christmas season.

Enjoy a private meeting with Santa in your cabin. Gather around as Santa listens to your Christmas wishes, chats about your year, and shares in the festive spirit. Each child will receive a special gift, making this a truly magical and memorable experience for the whole family.

Gather & Grill Raclette dinner in your cabin.

Day 3 Breakfast in your cabin.

Morning: Snowmobile Safari (2.5 hours)

Embark on a snowmobile safari through the untouched Lappish wilderness. After receiving driving instructions, safety equipment, and advice, you'll set off on the safari. Two adults will share a snowmobile, and children will ride in a sleigh pulled behind the guide's snowmobile. Lunch in your cabin.


Afternoon: Relax & Explore

Learn about the history and modern practices of raising these magnificent animals as you explore the farm. A knowledgeable guide will share fascinating insights into the history of reindeer herding and its role in Lapland today. To complete the experience, enjoy a scenic reindeer sleigh ride.

Afternoon: Lunch in Levi and Visit to the Town

In the afternoon, take a trip to the ski town of Levi, where you can explore a variety of souvenir and boutique shops, perfect for finding unique gifts and keepsakes. As you wander through the town, you'll also find cosy cafés and inviting restaurants, offering the perfect spot to relax.

Transfer to Kittilä Airport


Provisional flight times with our British Airways charter:

Location: The cabin is in a secluded area in the Levi region, Finland, approx. 200km north

of the Arctic Circle.

Average Temperatures: 0C to -45C

Daylight: 1st - 14th December approx.1 hour - 30 mins.

 $14^{\rm th}-31^{\rm st}$ December 0 hours of daylight. This is the special time of Kaamos or Polar Night when the sun does not go above the horizon. There is a twilight light

between 10:00 and 14:00.

Northern Lights: This is a great location to see the Northern Lights. Should the Aurora appear,

you will be able to see them from your cabin and do not need to book an

additional excursion.

Santa Experience: If your children write letters to Santa, we can make sure he receives them

before your visit. Each child will receive a special letter from Santa, personally inviting them to Lapland, as well as a soft toy to cherish during their visit.

Food: Meals are tailored to your preferences, freshly prepared, and delivered straight

to your cabin—where your host will set the table for you to enjoy.

Skiing: The ski slopes of Levi are just 20 minutes from your cabin. Each winter, Levi

hosts the Alpine Ski World Cup, making it a fantastic spot for snow sports. You can rent equipment and book ski school—and your host will be happy to assist

with arrangements.
